This week we will be working on the following:

Math

We will be understanding multiplication as extended addition.

3×5 is the same as $5 + 5 + 5$

Keep working with your children on money, specifically making change out of \$1, \$5, \$10....

Language Arts

Reading– We will be reading “Uncle Jed’s Barbershop,” a story dealing with the idea of saving for something you want very badly.

Phonics/Spelling– words with the /u/ (long u sound), /o/ sound as in flow, the /ow/sound as in brown..

Writing /Grammar – singular and plural possessive nouns – the cat’s paws; the cats’ paws.

Proofreading a paragraph.

Religion

Mary is our role model. She is an example of faith and trust in God.

We have special devotions to Our Lady such as the Rosary.

Social Studies

We will look at communities in the past like the Navajo tribe. How did they adapt to a desert environment?

Science

We will talk about the properties of matter.
